The name Church Day comes from the long standing German "Kirchentag" begun in 1949 by Reinhold von Thadden-Trieglaf as a lay movement following the isolation of the church from the state during the Nazi era. The purpose was to "draw together Protestant Christians in Germany in order to strengthen them in their faith, to prepare them for responsibility in their churches; to encourage them in witnessing in the world; and to have solidarity with those in the worldwide community of Christendom." Our developing "logo" for NCNC Church Day includes the term in all the languages spoken in our Conference Churches.
